

SSI ONLY TRACKING FORM

Keep track of you monthly wages and calculate the change in your SSI check.

1. Calculate your gross monthly wages by adding together all the paychecks you receive in a month. This can be from 1 to 5 checks depending on how often you are paid. Remember under SSI rules the month in which you receive the paycheck is when it is counted.
2. Use the gross monthly wage amount to figure the new SSI amount you will receive two months later.
